ABOUT FLEXION THERAPEUTICS



Flexion is a clinical-stage specialty pharmaceutical company focused on the development and commercialization of novel pain therapies. The company is currently advancing a portfolio of local, injectable, non-opioid drug candidates that have the potential to provide better and more persistent analgesia compared with existing therapy.

The company's lead product candidate, Zilretta™, has been designed to provide improved analgesic therapy for the five million patients who receive intra-articular (IA) injections for osteoarthritis (OA) of the knee annually. The company also has two additional product candidates, FX007, a locally administered TrkA receptor antagonist for post-operative pain, and FX005, an IA, sustained-release p38 MAP kinase inhibitor for end-stage OA patients.
